- Auditory and visual show with Aztec dance -

SMALL VENUES FORMAT

Reduced sized production

Includes contact information and technical requirements for audio and video show, input list, output list, stageplot, monitoring, backline and catering.





Contact information

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Welcome to the MUVA multisensory experience.

In this document you will find the technical details of your complete show. Be sure to read the rider correctly, for any doubt, correction or proposal-modification to it you should contact the production manager for approval.

Requirements of building and stage.
Additional Audio / Lighting / Video.

This rider is subjected to scouting or advance scouting and it is the responsibility of the show promoter/entrepreneur to contact the production manager at least two weeks prior to the show to fully advance the presentation.

For this concert format, the performance of live visuals and Aztec dances can only take place if the forum provides us with adequate space and the essential technical requirements.



ELECTRIC AC POWER

110V, 60Hz, stable, three-phase power plant, with sufficient capacity to power the equipment to be used. AC distribution network (120V) throughout the stage (marked on the plot) and in the console area. All must be grounded and properly polarized. Drums 2 outlets, Percussion 3 outlets, Guitar 2 outlets, Vox & Bass 2 outlets, Viola 2 outlets, Video 2 outlets, Ethnic Flutes 1 outlet.

SOUNDCHECK.

Soundchecks should be done within 2 hours from the time the stage is delivered by the local production, so they must take into account the time the equipment enters the building in order to avoid delays that may affect the performance of the show.

AUDIO (PA)

We require rested technical personnel with good disposition and with the capacity to solve any type of eventuality.

It is essential to have a PROFESSIONAL audio equipment according to the capacity of both the place and the audience, we must have original equipment, no copy, clone, "spells" or "type" equipment will be accepted, as it could affect the performance of the same, demeriting the quality sought.

The equipment must always be approved by MUVA's audio engineer and approved by the production.

FOH

Audio Console

1 HIGH RANGE digital console (make and model indistinct) with **minimum 24 input channels and 8 output channels.**

With the latest available software version installed.

MONITORS

01 return snake with 8 FOH channels to monitor console on stage 06 Floor monitors

MICROPHONES, DIRECT BOXES AND STANDS.

Microphones and direct boxes according to the indicated input list, contemplating a spare stock.



BACKLINE

Drums

01 x High end drums indistinct model.

01 x 20 x20" bass drum

01 x 10" Air Tom

01 x Floor tom 14".

05 x High end stands for cymbals, any brand and model.

01 x High end hi hats stand. Brand and model indistinct.

02 x High end stands for hi hats. Make and model indistinct (Snare and teponaztli).

01 x Drum mat.

01 x Drum throne (reinforced drum bench).

The drumheads for bass drum and toms must be in good condition.

If you do not have any of these requirements, please send a contra rider and contact MUVA production.

Guitars

01 x Guitar amplifier (optimum) Fender Twin reverb, optional Fender Deluxe, Fender Deville, or marshall jcm900

02 x High-end reinforced guitar stand (guitars)

Bass

01 x Ampeg SVT Pro (Optimum) Bass Head with 4 x10 Min. 500 v RMS cabinet, or similar.

01 x High-end reinforced bass stand.

Percussion

01 x High range Djembe with stand (model and brand indistinct).

01 x Percussion table. LP 760A

01 x Drum throne (reinforced bench for drums)

03 x High range reinforced stands for cymbals.

01 x Reinforced high-end cymbal stand (any brand and model)

All percussion heads must be in good condition and tuning key must be provided. If you do not have any of these requirements, please send a contra rider and contact MUVA production.

For the multisensory performance option (visual, auditory), as an optimal option, and for greater control of lighting and projection, we recommend **NIGHT SHOWS IN CONTENT FORUM, FREE OF LIGHT**

CONTAMINATION In this option we recommend first, modular LED screen at 2 meters high with respect to the stage or as a second option projectors according to the quality and proportions of the event, with central main projection screens.

The video signal is delivered to the stage in HDMI or VGA, in Vj position.

The central screen, either projection or modular LED screen, has to be mounted at a height of 2 meters with respect to the stage (Example Fig 1, lighting section).

ESSENTIAL LIGHTING

06 LEEKOS zenithal with cutters10 pair (led preferably)02 one smoke machine, (normal smoke and low smoke)Control console indistinct, but check with MUVA production.

OPTIONAL LIGHTING

NO GOBOS

Racers

Riggers must be provided by the venue

All lighting at all times must be zenithal with the beam cut off at least one meter from the projection screen.

ARTISTS/PRODUCTION OFFICE DRESSING ROOMS

1 dressing room is required:

14 x Chairs

02 x Full-length mirror with illumination.

02 x Electrical outlet with multi-contacts.

01 x Private bathroom

01 x Catering table

06 x Facial towels

Adequate ventilation and lighting

02 x Fans if required due to weather conditions.

Optional internet access

Direct access to the stage

Security personnel: THE ARTISTS reserve the right of admission to their respective dressing rooms and all control is in charge of the PRODUCTION MANAGER.

CATERING

- * Any alcoholic beverage that is contemplated within the catering standard to be provided, must be delivered only and exclusively to the Production Manager, during or at the end of the show, **NOT BEFORE.**
- * These requirements are based on Mexican standards, if this document is read outside of Mexico, we can adapt to what is contemplated as standard catering service.

The catering service consists of 2 types of services: Assembly/Soundcheck and Show..

LOADING/SOUNDCHECK (FOR PRODUCTION, TECHNICAL PERSONNEL - STAFF AND MUSICIANS):

Assortment of bottled water, and energy drinks (NO soft drinks, NO beer, NO alcohol). Available upon crew arrival.

CATERING FOR SHOW:

All of this should be set up at least 30 minutes before the show

- ARTISTS AND CREW (according to Mexican standards)
- 01 x Bag of clean ice
- 01 x Cold meat tray and assorted cheeses o Tray of assorted seasonal fruits
- 01 x Assortment of sandwiches (open to proposals)
- 01 x Coffee maker
- 01 x Clean ice bucket Assortment of soft drinks, bottled water, mineral water and energy drinks (coke zero) Disposable cups, napkins and plates.
- 01 Trash can

In our eagerness to mediate as much as possible, for the entire satisfaction of whoever MUVA contemplates for a presentation, we want to be very punctual in the fact that we are open to hear counterproposal of any of the items described here, and we emphasize that any modification to the needs specified here, must be of bilateral agreement and always with notification to the production manager.
